SUBJECT: OMHA BULLETIN 210319-015-I – PROGRAMMING UPDATE



Please note the following programming updates applicable to OMHA Bulletin 210319-015-I, issued March 19, 2021 and which has been included with this bulletin:

SEASONAL START DATE

Resumption of sanctioned programming will begin the Tuesday following Labour Day - **September 7, 2021**. This applies to all programming, both on-ice and off-ice.

CATEGORIZATION - REPRESENTATIVE PROGRAMMING – U9

Amendments to OHF Playing Regulations resulted in the elimination of all competitive (Representative) categories at U9. The implementation of this decision has been deferred for one season.

This programming will remain available for the 2021-2022 season *only*.

Should an Association choose to provide Representative U9 programming in 2021-2022, tryout timelines by category as indicated for U11 will apply:

AAA Tryouts begin	Sep. 13, 2021 (7 days)
AAA Development Phase Begins	Sep. 20 (minimum 7 Days)
AA Tryouts begin	Sep. 20, 2021 (7 days)
AA Development Phase Begins	Sep. 27 (minimum 7 Days)
A & below Tryouts begin	Sep. 27, 2021 (7 days)
A & below Development Phase Begins	Oct. 4 (minimum 7 Days)

Moving forward, implementation of the OHF decision in the OMHA will take effect beginning with the 2022-2023 season and the only categories permitted at U9 will be House League (HL), Local League (LL) and Minor Development (MD).

CATEGORIZATION - REPRESENTATIVE PROGRAMMING - AE

Amendments to OHF Playing Regulations defining Categories has also resulted in AE no longer being identified as a stand-alone category. As with U9 Representative programming, implementation has been deferred for one year to allow sufficient time to modify and transition existing programming as originally indicated.

SUBJECT: OHF BULLETIN ID: 21-013 – SEASONAL CALENDAR FOR TRADITIONAL MINOR HOCKEY

Attached please find the above-referenced Ontario Hockey Federation Bulletin issued regarding Seasonal Calendar for Traditional Minor Hockey.

The OHF has approved the 2021-22 Seasonal Calendar for traditional Minor Hockey. The modification of the 2021-22 Seasonal Calendar was necessitated by the OHF's earlier decision to move all tryouts and evaluations to the fall of 2021 due to COVID-19 restrictions.

It is also expected that next week the OHF will formally announce the outcomes of the OHF Semi-Annual Meeting held on Feb. 27, 2021, and additional details will be forwarded at that time. However, there was a significant decision made at that meeting which impacts OMHA programming effective the 2021-22 season.

An amendment to OHF Playing Regulation C4 was passed, which resulted in the removal of all competitive categories of hockey (AAA, AA, A, B, BB, C, CC, D) for U9 and below. This means the elimination of Representative hockey at U9 (formerly Novice).

This change had been implemented throughout most of the OHF jurisdiction following the Open Ice Summit (1999), however, is now formalized with the full implementation of the Hockey Canada Timbits U7 and U9 Canadian Player Pathways.

Key information and dates for the 2021-22 Seasonal Calendar are identified below:

General

- No on-ice activity is permitted until Tuesday, September 7, 2021
- Sanctioned Tournaments are permitted to start on October 8, 2021
- All Minor Hockey teams must be engaged in meaningful hockey on March 1, 2022

U12 & Above

- U12 and above Minor Hockey tryouts will begin the first Friday following Labour Day
- The requirement to offer a Player Registration by the end of the fourth day applies only to Associations in the Lake Ontario Region (LOR)

Important Dates –

- Optional Prep Phase begins Sep. 7, 2021
This provides a window to offer player & goaltender development sessions as well as Checking instruction prior to Tryouts.
- AAA Tryouts begin Sep. 10, 2021 (7 days)
- AA Tryouts begin Sep. 17, 2021 (7 days)
- A & below Tryouts begin Sep. 24, 2021 (7 days)

U11

- The Hockey Canada U11 Pathway will be fully implemented for the 2021-22 season.
- U11 must adhere to OHF Playing Regulation G4

Important Dates –

- AAA Tryouts begin Sep. 13, 2021 (7 days)
- AAA Development Phase begins Sep. 20 (minimum 7 days)
- AA Tryouts begin Sep. 20, 2021 (7 days)
- AA Development Phase begins Sep. 27 (minimum 7 days)
- A & below Tryouts begin Sep. 27, 2021 (7 days)
- A & below Development Phase begins Oct. 4 (minimum 7 days)

U9 & Below

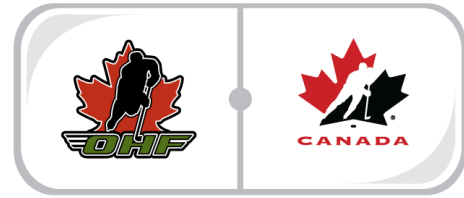
- U7 and U9 must adhere to OHF Playing Regulation G3

- Development Phase begins Sep. 20, 2021

2021-22 OHF Seasonal Calendar for Traditional Minor Hockey

At its Semi-Annual Meeting of Members, the Ontario Hockey Federation approved the 2021-22 seasonal calendar for traditional Minor Hockey. The modification of the 2021-22 seasonal calendar was necessitated by the OHF's earlier decision to move all tryouts and evaluations to the fall of 2021 because of COVID-19 restrictions.

The 2021-22 OHF seasonal calendar for minor hockey was built on the following principles:

- U7 and U9 must adhere to OHF Playing Regulation G3
- U11 must adhere to OHF Playing Regulation G4
- No on-ice activity be permitted until the Tuesday following Labour Day
- U12 and above Minor Hockey tryouts will begin the first Friday following Labour Day
- Tournaments permitted to started October 8th
- All Minor Hockey teams must be engaged in meaningful hockey on March 1st, 2022

The approved seasonal calendar provides an opportunity for Members and associations to deliver optional prep phase programming beginning the Tuesday following Labour Day until the first day of tryouts/evaluations. It has been recommended that associations deliver a minimum of one on-ice body checking education session for the U14 and U15 Divisions in Categories where body checking is permitted. This recommendation is provided on the understanding that many athletes will not have previously participated in a program where body checking has been permitted prior to the upcoming season.

The OHF understands the value and importance of tournaments to both associations and participants. That said, the overwhelming feedback from associations noted ice shortages to start the season. In consideration of the conflicting demands for ice, the OHF has made the decision to set October 8th as the first day for tournaments. While this was a difficult decision, it was made to ensure sufficient ice remains available to accommodate the proper evaluation of our participants and the orderly formation of teams. At this time the sanctioning of tournaments remains on hold and tournament operators are not permitted



to collect registration fees. The OHF and its Members expect to provide additional guidance pertaining to sanctioning and the collection of registration fees in the coming weeks.

With the approval of the seasonal calendar the OHF will now update associated Playing Regulations to accommodate traditional player movement during the fall 2021 tryout period. We expect the associated Playing Regulations to be released following approval by the Members at a Special Meeting of the Members scheduled to occur April 15, 2021.

Below you will find:

- Approved U13/U15/U18 calendar
- U11 calendar (in accordance with Playing Regulation G4)
- U7 and U9 calendar (in accordance with Playing Regulation G3)

Should any questions arise, do not hesitate to reach out for clarification. We look forward to and hope for a return to a traditional season in September 2021.

Note: The approved calendar assumes a return to traditional hockey without COVID-19 restrictions. Over the next number of months, the OHF is committed to reassessing its Return to Hockey Framework to identify necessary amendments to accommodate Ontario Law should it become evident that COVID-19 restrictions remain in place to start the 2021-22 season.
