OHF Role and Commitments

- Overall implementation and delivery of the pilot and the reporting back to Hockey Canada.
- To organize Evaluators to conduct individual evaluations of each team's players in September, December and March.
- To collect and compile the data from the individual player evaluations.
- To coordinate the review of the video and the collection of data from the video platform.
- To compile the data for reporting to Hockey Canada.
- To provide access to the Hockey Canada App to all Head Coaches to access practice plans (tutorial on app to be provided).
- To provide evaluation sheets to the coaches for tracking of shots.

Member Role and Commitments

- Need to work with their Associations and confirm the schedules from all of the participating associations and specific teams.
- Need to work with their Associations and confirm the facilities being used and if there is video capture of games within the facilities.
- Need to grant access to the data in Game Sheet Inc. for scores and player stats.
- To help identify individuals to conduct the evaluations.
- Alliance to verify that game play is two half ice games at the same time.
- To conduct a survey of the parents and players on experience. Survey provided by OHF.
- Scheduling of games in facilities that have LiveBarn or video as much as possible.

Association's Role and Commitment

- To ensure that they are running on average three (3) ice times per week with two (2) practices and one (1) game.
- To ensure that coaches are delivering the provided practice plans throughout the season.
- To provide access to the LiveBarn or other video feed for all games of the U9 Pilot programs. **(Monday, September 9, 2024)**
- To provide to their Member all calendar of events for their U9 team involved in the pilot. **(Monday, September 9, 2024) at minimum September and October.**
- To set aside one practice in September, December and March for Evaluator to conduct individual player evaluation session.
- To provide budgets for each of the teams involved in the pilot.
- To provide OHF with coaches contact information (phone and email). For Network App and facilitating evaluation sessions. **(Monday, September 9, 2024)**

Coach's Role and Commitment

- Communicate with the Association any changes in the schedule of program.
- Build into the schedule the individual evaluation segment that coach will run and evaluator will attend. Players need to be in game sweaters for number identification.
- Players must wear sweaters out of pants so numbers are visible in all games.
- Utilize the Hockey Canada Network App for accessing the practice plans (app provided by OHF).
- Identify an individual parent or coach to fill out the shots on net and tracking of shot location, goals and game scores.
- To utilize the evaluation tool to conduct an evaluation of players in September, December, and March on Game Play.
