SUBJECT: 2024-25 SEASONAL CALENDAR – GAMES PERMITTED DURING DEVELOPMENT PHASE

The following update is applicable to OMHA Bulletin 231102-014-I – 2024-25 Seasonal Calendar originally issued 2 November 2023 and OMHA Bulletin 240321-30-I – 2024-25 Seasonal Calendar – Player Evaluation Dates.

The Ontario Hockey Federation (OHF) has confirmed the number of games permitted during the Development Phase of the 2024-25 season.

Development Phase U10 & up	Teams selected in the Spring may begin sanctioned Team activity starting August 26 with no exhibition games.
	Development Phase runs for 27 days and begins following Labour Day – September 3 through 29.
	During this timeframe, teams may participate on a maximum of:
	i. Four (4) Exhibition Games OR;
	ii. Two (2) Exhibition Games and one (1) Tournament
	This is based on the required ratio of two (2) practices for every one (1) game.
	Tournament participation for all Divisions and Categories permitted to start September 20.

* Reminder for Teams selected in the Fall *

Development Phase must be a minimum of 14 days regardless of start date.

Following a recommendation at the OHF Member Forum, Playing Regulation G4(i) has been amended and approved by the OHF Board of Directors for the upcoming season and beyond.

(i) Development Phase and Tournaments for U11 and above

i. For the Divisions of U11 and above Teams selected in the spring can run Team building activities with no exhibition games the last week of August. For the Divisions of U11 and above following Labour Day Monday there is a twenty-seven (27) day Development Phase where teams may only practice and play a maximum of four (4) exhibition games or two (2) exhibition games and one Tournament in in accordance with G4(i) ii and two (2) practices for every one (1) game.

ii. For the Divisions of U11 and above beginning the eighteenth (18) day after Labour Day Monday Tournaments may begin.

SUBJECT: 2024-25 SEASONAL CALENDAR

The Ontario Hockey Federation (OHF) has approved key dates and details regarding the Seasonal Calendar for the 2024-25 season. This model adheres to the key concepts and principles of the Canadian Player Pathways framework from Hockey Canada.

GENERAL INFORMATION

PLAYER EVALUATIONS

Player Evaluations for Representative teams will again take place in the Spring as was implemented for the 2023-24 season.

Typically, Spring Player Evaluations begin the Monday following OHF Championships. 2024 OHF Championships are scheduled for the third weekend of April – **April 19-21, 2023**

New for 2024-25 and in an effort to maximize available ice-time, Player Evaluations for Divisions that are not eligible for the 2024 OHF Championships will be begin on **Saturday**, **April 20**th.

Divisions that are eligible for OHF Championships will begin the Monday after OHF Championships, as past practice, on **Monday, April 22nd.**

TOURNAMENTS

Tournament participation for all Divisions and Categories permitted to start September 20, 2024.

REGULAR SEASON

The regular season for all Divisions and Categories permitted to start September 30, 2024.

All teams must be engaged in meaningful competition until March 1, 2024 – No teams may be eliminated from competition before this date.
