Associations may provide sanctioned individual skills training or hockey schools – August 10 - September 4, 2026.

Teams selected in the Spring may begin sanctioned Team activity August 31, 2026 (No Exhibition Games prior to Labour Day).

This programming requires sanctioning from the OMHA and includes registration through the HCR.

September 5-7, 2026: No Sanctioned Programming.

SUBJECT: 2026-27 SEASONAL CALENDAR

The Ontario Hockey Federation (OHF) has approved key dates and details regarding the Seasonal Calendar for the 2026-27 season. This model adheres to the key concepts and principles of the Canadian Player Pathways framework from Hockey Canada.

See enclosed **OHF bulletin 25-046 - 2026 - 2027 Seasonal Calendar Key Dates**

In addition, the OMHA has identified additional information and direction on the following items:

U8 & U9

- Player Evaluations for U8 & U9 Minor Development (MD) will be permitted to take place in the Spring beginning **Saturday 11 April 2026**.
- These evaluations may take place over a 14-day window (April 11 – 24)
- The Development Phase for U9 & below will be finalized in January when confirmation is received from Hockey Canada through OHF regarding U9 pilot and game play models.

Addition of a Fourth Player Evaluation Window

- Player Evaluations held in the spring will be divided into four (4) 7-day Evaluation windows.
- Previously, there were only three (3) windows with “A” & below taking place in the third window.
- For 2026-27, Evaluations for “A” category teams will take place in the third window and Evaluations for “B” category teams will take place in the fourth window.

BB Category

- Also of note, Evaluations for “BB” category teams will take place in the third Evaluation window along with “A” category teams.
- This reiterates the OMHA’s position that the “BB” category is “A”-equivalent programming simply without body checking.

Change in terminology from Tryout to Player Evaluation

To align OHF definitions with that of the Hockey Canada Player Pathways.

Player Evaluation provides flexibility in the format that Associations' tier their Registered Participants. Whereas with Tryouts a player either makes the team or does not. Player Evaluations still allows and encourage Associations to tier players with like skill.
